

2019 Small Works Roster
PUD No. 1 of Whatcom County
Request for Applications

Notice is hereby given that Public Utility District No. 1 of Whatcom County (Whatcom PUD) is accepting applications from qualified contractors wishing to be approved for listing upon Whatcom PUD's 2019 Small Works Roster. Contractors whose names appear on the Roster may submit job/bid proposals for public works contracts that are less than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) (RCWs 54.04.070 & 39.04.155).

To be considered by Whatcom PUD and approved to be included on Whatcom PUD's Small Works Roster each contractor shall: be a responsible bidder as defined by current Washington State Law; have a current Certificate of Registration as a Contractor in the State of Washington; have a current Washington State Unified Business Identifier number; if applicable, Industrial Insurance coverage for the applicant's employees working in the State of Washington; have an Employment Security Department number; have a Washington State Excise Tax registration number; have a Workmen's Compensation Experience Factor equal to or less than one (1.0); have the ability to bond projects in the amount of \$300,000 or less; have personnel with a minimum of five (5) years' experience in the trade or scope of work indicated in the Application; be able to submit a Certificate of Insurance for the minimum amounts indicated in the Application; and have satisfactory qualifications to receive Safety Training and Security Clearances from Whatcom PUD's industrial customers.

Whatcom PUD is seeking qualified contractors for the following classifications of work; a more detailed description of each item is included in the Application.

Whatcom PUD will provide written email confirmation to the applicant as to the status of the application (approval or denial).

The 2019 Roster shall be in effect through 31 December 2019 and will be updated on an annual basis.
